



## RESULTS.

### At-Risk Students in High School Standardized Testing

A study was conducted at Baldwin High School in Georgia to evaluate how using KeyTrain impacted the performance of at-risk students on the Georgia High School Graduation Test (GHSGT). The results of this study revealed that the KeyTrain remediation courses had a dramatic effect in improving the academic performance of the students who used KeyTrain on the mathematics and English/language arts sections of the GHSGT. The most significant gains were seen in the special education, low socio economic, and African American subgroups on the mathematics section of the test. Based on a statistical analysis of the data, all of the experimental subgroups showed statistically significant improvements on both the mathematics and English/language arts sections of the GHSGT.

#### Results:
